

Important information about new agreement terms and conditions and regulations for acquiring card transactions

Dear customer,

Euroline's new general terms and conditions and regulations explain the importance of increased security when accepting cards as a means of payment and when handling card data. In order to maintain confidence in the use of cards as a means of payment, the international payment card schemes, spearheaded by Visa and MasterCard, are increasing their security requirements in order to reduce the risk of fraud. We are therefore making some important changes to our terms and conditions so that we can work together to safeguard and reinforce market confidence in card payments.

Key changes

- Special obligations in conjunction with sales over the Internet, mail and telephone order (section 2)
- Verification (section 3.3)
- Reporting (section 5.2)
- Specifically regarding sales over the Internet (section 6)
- Security (sections 7.1 and 7.6)
